# Test to Stay

For Unvaccinated Students



### 1. Permission Needed

Give approval for your child to be tested.



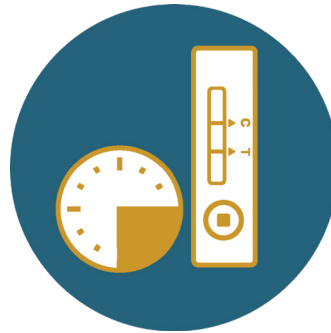
### 2. Parent/Guardian Presence

A parent/guardian must remain on campus until their child's test result is ready.



### 3. Testing at School

School nurse Patty Cody will administer tests at 7:30 a.m. Students will be tested at least 2x during days 1-5 following exposure.



### 4. Antigen Test

Your student will receive a rapid antigen test using a lower nasal swab. Results will be known in 15 minutes.



### 5. Test Positive

Students who test positive must isolate at home even if they have no symptoms for at least five days.



### 6. Test Negative

Students who test negative stay in school.



### 7. Students Who Don't Test

Students not tested must complete their full quarantine at home.

# Test to Stay

## For Unvaccinated Students

Unvaccinated students participating in the Test to Stay program will be tested a minimum of 2 days during the 5 days following exposure. As a reminder, Day 0 is the day of last exposure to a positive COVID-19 case in a school setting. Students participating in Test to Stay are still quarantined outside of school instruction/academic periods.

# Early Return

## For COVID-Positive Students

Students who test positive for COVID-19 will be required to isolate, staying separate from other members of their home, for a minimum of 5 days (regardless of vaccination status). If symptoms persist, further isolation will be required; otherwise, they may attend school after the 5-day isolation.

Day 0 is the date symptoms first started or the date a specimen for a positive test was taken.

Isolation ends after 5 full days if you are fever-free for 24 hours (without meds) and other symptoms have improved.

NYSDOH advises no travel during days 6-10. In addition, they state that people should not go to places where masks are removed and should avoid eating around others. EFS asks students to eat lunch and have snack/water breaks away from others during this time period. Also, students will not participate in other extracurriculars such as music, PE, sports, and other after school activities until after day 10.
